### **Rethinking Your Abilities in Christ**

- ❖ 2 Corinthians 2:12-6:13. Paul's confidence:
  - ➤ Of their sincerity and commission from God
  - ➤Of the credibility of their ministry and message
    - 2 Corinthians 2:17-3:6, 4:1-2
  - Their = us, we, including you, the church
  - > We Christians are all a new creation
    - Ministers of reconciliation,
    - Ambassadors for Christ
    - The righteousness of God
    - Working together with him (2 Corinthians 5:16-6:1)

#### What Is That In Your Hand?

- Exodus 3-4. God appeared to Moses in a burning bush and made him his minister
  - ➤ God would work through Moses to free his people
  - Moses was afraid and kept making excuses
  - ➤ GOD GAVE MOSES ASSURANCE OF HIS PRESENCE TO GIVE HIM CONFIDENCE (See Exodus 4)
    - Moses was a shepherd and the staff was his tool
    - God used the staff of Moses in his hand
    - God used Aaron, Moses' brother, to help him

### **Our Sufficiency Comes From God**

- ❖ 2 Corinthians 3:1-6. Today God still helps and backs up the ministers of His new covenant.
  - God was with Moses and God is with us.
  - ➤ Believe it! Our ministry is greater than the ministry of Moses and Israel.
    - The Letter of the Law of Moses is a ministry of death not life because the letter kills. Why? It's insufficient as a tool or staff of God in the hands of his ministers.
    - In contrast the ministry of the Spirit is the tool or staff of God in our hearts that enables us to give life.

#### **You Are Letters From Christ**

- ❖ 2 Corinthians 3:1-6. Results bolster boldness
  - The ministry of the Spirit gets results that can be read by everyone.
    - Not a boast in godless human pride and wisdom
  - The result is what can be read in the lives of the people of Christ who are letters of Christ.
    - Christians are letters of recommendation making others want to hear more and become Christians too.
    - The source of the results is the Spirit and the Spirit is the ink or writing upon our hearts.

## The Writing on Your Hearts

- The Holy Spirit inspired all scripture: Old Testament and New Testament
  - ➤ Both are writings in letters and words which are the word of God because God gave them.
  - ➤ Yet the Old Covenant is by <u>letter</u> to distinguish its lack of effectiveness from the effectiveness of the New Covenant which is by the <u>Spirit</u> the better staff or tool for the job.
  - ➤ This distinctive emphasis that the New Testament is more than letter because it describes the new way of the Spirit of Christ in our hearts.
- Challenge: To build our resume testifying to God by pursuing transformation in His image by the Spirit of the Lord Christ.
